


#### **DEFINITIONS**

**Distinct** = number of unique students (one student is only counted one time)

Duplicate = students are counted more than once if they attended more than one college at PCCD or

more than one semester

Disabled Students = students with documented disabilities at PCCD

**Special Admit = includes high school and Adult Education Learners**
