

## DEFINITIONS

**Distinct** = number of unique students (one student is only counted one time)

**Duplicate** = students are counted more than once if they attended more than one college at PCCD or more than one semester

**Disabled Students** = students with documented disabilities at PCCD

**Special Admit** = includes high school and Adult Education Learners
