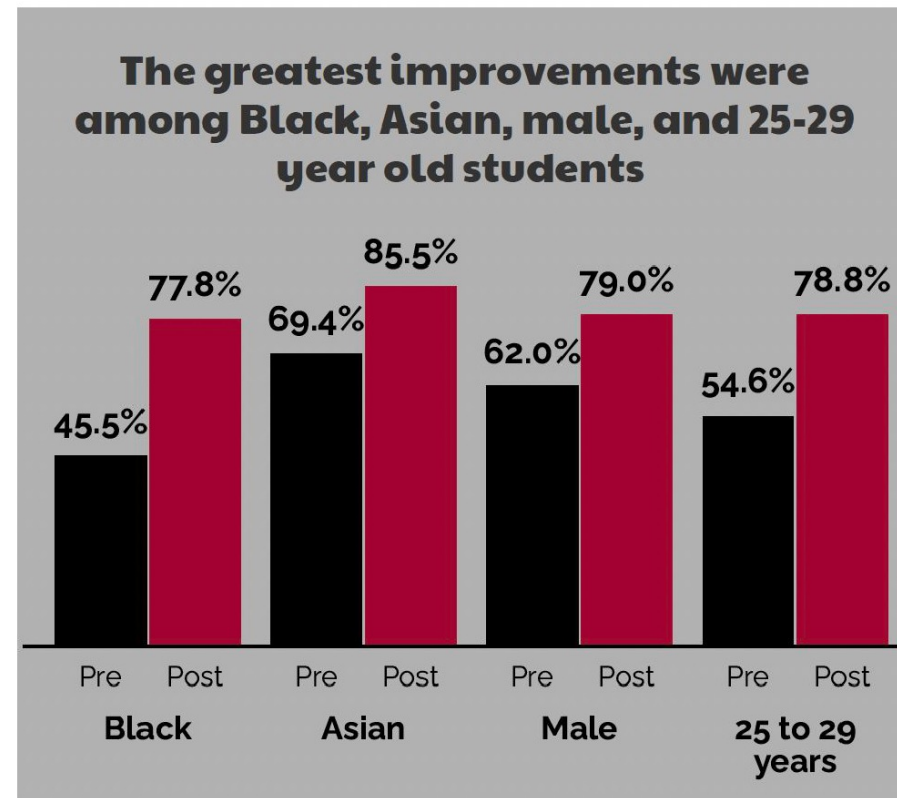
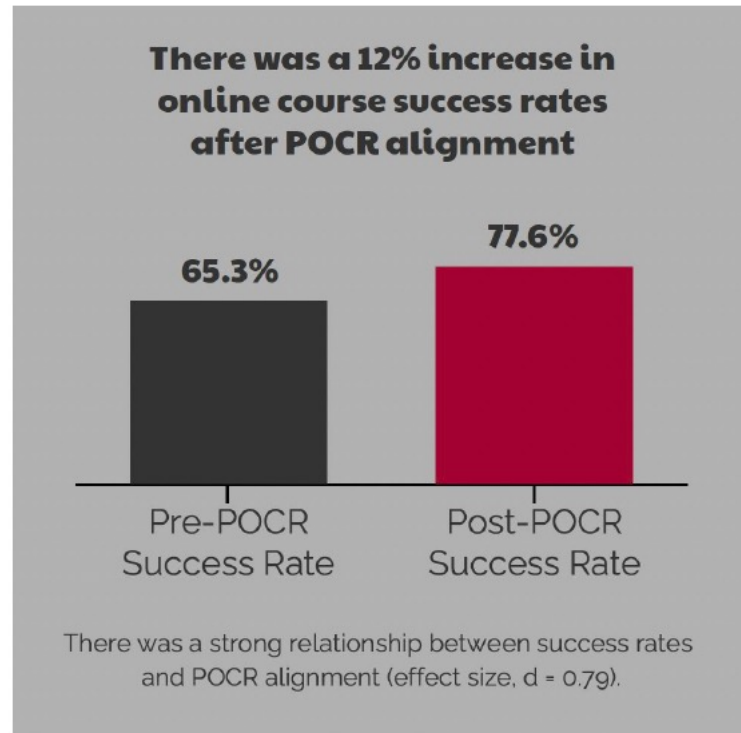

- Quality-reviewed courses align with all of 44 criteria:
  - Section A- Content Presentation
    - Example: Are there instructions for working with content?
  - Section B- Interaction
    - Example- Is there a clear communication plan?
  - Section C- Assessment
    - Example- Are the assignments Authentic?
  - Section D- Accessibility
    - Example- Headings (use the Rich Content Editor)

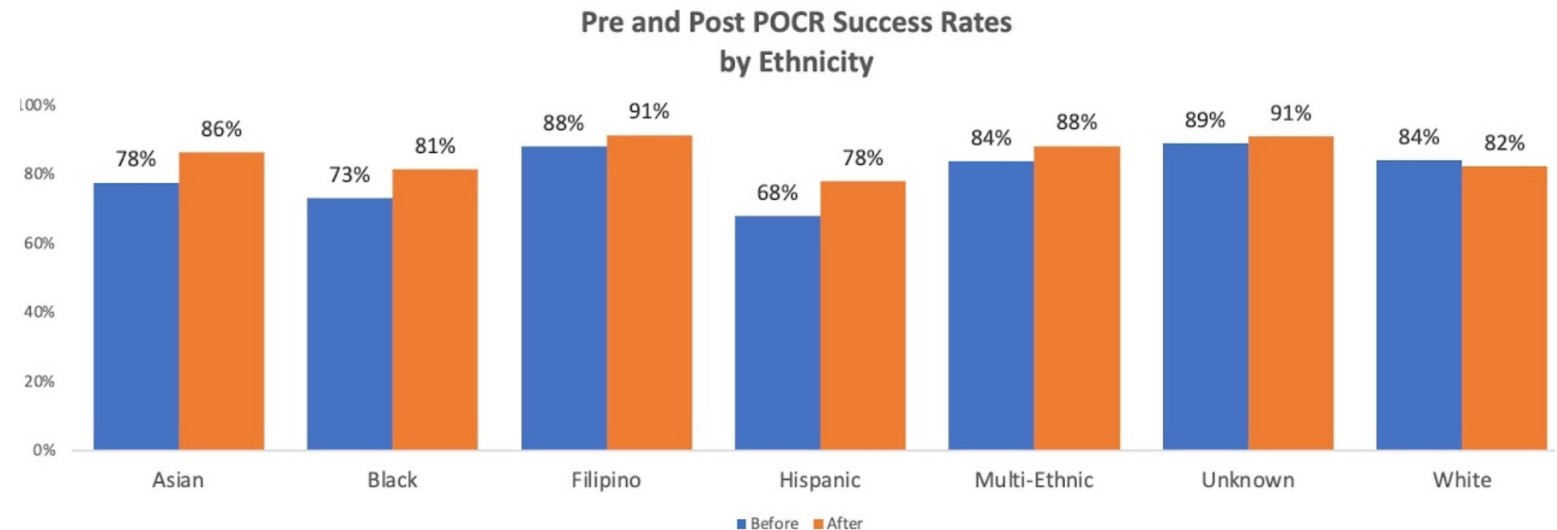
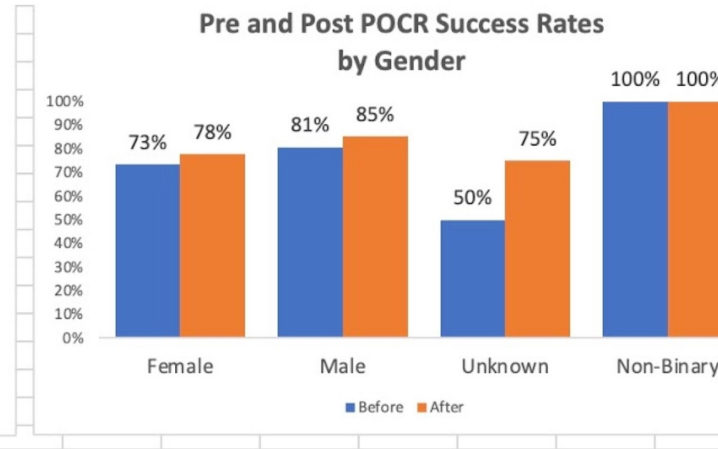
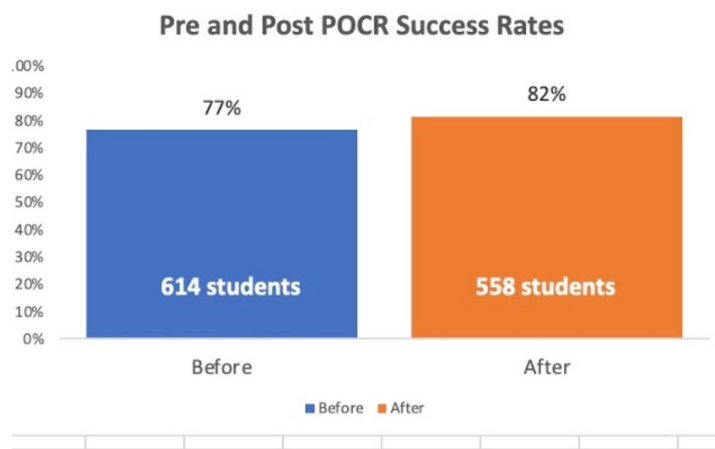
# Benefits of Quality-Review Badged courses (Chaffee)

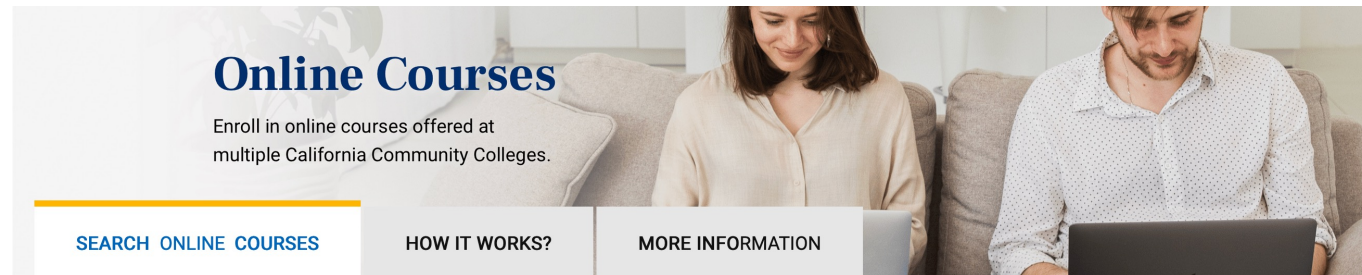

- 40% of Searches return to the student's Home College

# How to optimize Quality-review Badging

- Courses are badged by the instructor-
  - For example- If my English 5 course is badged, not all English 5 sections are badged.
- Badged Instructors can trade
  - For example- If my English 5 is badged and Adán's English 1A is badged, we can trade badged courses and they will both be badged for both of us.

# Search Trends (November 23)

- 22-23 academic year:
  - most searched course by keyword:
    - Calculus (24250 students)
    - Physics (16565 students)
    - Statistics (11426 students)
  - The only non-GE subject to make the top 20 was Real Estate (5,729 searches)
  - GE requirement:
    - Ethnic Studies (1300 students since Summer '23).
- The single term with the most cross-enrollments was summer 2023 with 2,506.

# Other Data

- Rancho Santiago CCD has the most enrollments of any district, despite only launching in fall 2022. As of summer 2023, RSCCD had 1,177 cross enrollments.
- The single college with the most cross-enrollments to date is Chaffey College with 889. Chaffey went live in fall 2021.
