- Demolition completed
- 2118 will be an expansion of the Berkeley City College campus
 - ❖ 5 story, 60,000 square foot building
- Division of State Architects plans are approved and ready to rebid using general contractor on hand
- Goal
 - ❖ To have Grossman Price contract available to the Board for consideration next year
 - Once approved they can start commissioning a brand-new building in the summer of 2024
 - During the interim use, the site for events
 - 2118 anticipated to be ready and occupied by Fall 2026(unofficially)
