6. Budget Updates		 BCC's 2024-25 budget is \$26,863,000, a 4.3% increase from last year. However, we no longer have the pandemic funding that we had before. District-wide cost-saving measures implemented, including salary savings sweeps and collaborative purchasing. We are looking across the District and Colleges to see how we can be more efficient of our spending. Audit of under-used equipment to reduce unnecessary costs. College-level strategies: Intentional leveraging of categorical and grant funds Vice Presidents to report on discretionary fund spending before December Timeline-based spending to avoid lastminute fund depletion
