There are minor differences between face to face and distance education success rates. In order to raise the success rates for distance education courses to the level of both the discipline average and the institutional goal, we will focus on further assessment and consistency across courses. As of now, assessment of online courses is the same as face-to-face courses which does not allow us to address these differences. A new assessment model must be formulated.

Communication retention rates remain higher than the average for the college.

Our program has been active in researching specific resources and services for students with high communication anxiety. Because our courses all require some sort of speaking, it is vital to address this issue early and regularly. Second, we have been active in developing and using an early alert system as well as working with counselors and disability services to be sure that our students have access to services. To improve over the next three years, we will design and implement a comprehensive program for students with high communication anxiety. These services will include a public speaking lab, workshop and tutors.
