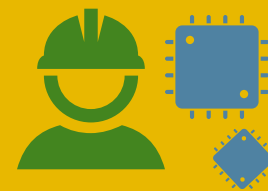




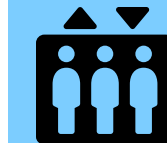
Laney Facilities & Technology Updates



Leak Remediation Project

Hooray! The second phase of the Leak Remediation Project is substantially complete.

Tower Elevator Project

Unfortunately, the Tower Elevator Project is delayed due to Department of State Architect issues.

We hope to have an updated timeline by November 1st.

Blue Phones Project

To enhance safety across campus, work has begun to replace and update emergency blue phones. The new advanced phone equipment will include video cameras and audio speakers. The project is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2018.

Bakery Oven

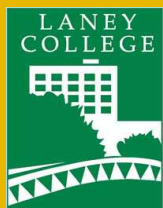
Finally, the new bakery oven is going to be installed. It's been a long time coming so we're excited that Spring 2019 classes in the bakery department will have a beautiful new oven!



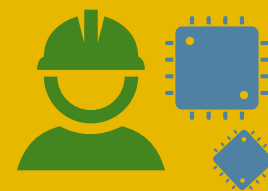
BEST Center

Laney Library Elevator

The Laney Library elevator needs major repairs.

The contract for Kone Elevator was approved at the September Board of Trustees meeting. Repairs are expected to take approximately 17 weeks once the contract is executed and funded.

We expect the Library elevator to be back in service by spring semester. In the meantime, here is how you can access library services and resources:

IMC (Copy Center)

Faculty who have difficulty negotiating the stairs can make arrangements for copy services with IMC staff by calling 510-464-3489 or emailing copy requests to laneyimc@peralta.edu and requesting delivery to your mailbox. (Tests cannot be left in mailbox.)

If it is an urgent request, library staff can assist with dropping off orders and picking up copies from the IMC counter.

LIBRARY ORIENTATIONS (L-104)

Librarians have developed a system to accommodate students and faculty who are unable to negotiate the stairs down to L-104. RESTROOMS

Library restrooms are located on the 1st, 3rd, and 4th floors of the library. From the main floor (2nd floor), the nearest accessible restrooms are located:

- Women's Restroom: A-266
- Men's Restroom: A-205
- Gender-neutral: Tower Building (2nd – 8th Floors) [A-238 access in progress]

BOOKS

Library staff will retrieve books for students and faculty who need books that are shelved on the 3rd and 4th floors of the library.

AUDIO VISUAL EQUIPMENT

LISTENING & VIEWING
