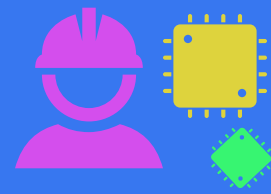

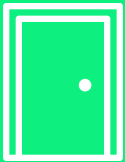
## Construction News
