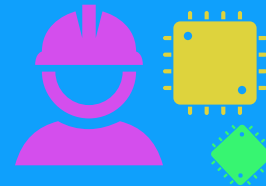

## Lighting Project Update

Lighting projects at the Field House and Tower Building will be completed by June 8th. These new energy efficient lighting systems had programmable dimmers and the office motion sensors have been replaced to avoid lights turning off or flickering while in use.
