







## Facilities & Technology Update

# July 2021



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District General Services is  accessing the results of the HVAC reports from Forensic Analytics. In the meantime, the flushing of the water system and testing will start  the week of July 26th.

Planning for fall face to face  classes continues. Deep  cleaning of the campus continues and will be complete before fall semester begins.

While we are still awaiting definitive guidance from the district, If you have special needs for your fall classroom or lab please work with your Dean.

 The perimeter paving has  commenced and should be complete by August 3rd. From July 26 – August 3rd there will be no on-campus parking or car charging available. Parking is available in the faculty staff lot or on the street. Be sure to pay the meter if parking in the street.

 The upper garden area behind the bistro will be removed to make way for construction of the new library and EBMUD pipes. The fruit trees will be relocated to the district. The roses and other flowers will be planted around campus. We have several large constructions projects that will be working around that area (locker room renovation, central utility plant modernization, relocation of Eagle Village and new library, learning resource center). Once construction is complete, we'll work with end users on the landscaping and gardens in that area.

  Parking permits should be available for fall semester, though we are still waiting for final guidance from the district. Full-time employees should complete [this application](#). A new fence is going to be installed around the BEST Center along with the window replacement. We expect this building will be available for use for Spring semester.



Several door, window and fencing repairs have been made, include the long overdue gate repair to the baseball bathrooms.



The Fablab will be relocating to the Art Center. A project manager has been assigned to the project and planning is underway.



Leak Remediation Phase III – pending board approval at the end of July, this final phase of leak remediation is slated to being late August.



The Union Bank Branch in the student center will be complete by the end of August.

Over the next several months, Laney IT will be working on a major project to upgrade the labs with new computers. A more detailed plan will be shared once equipment is ordered.

A new application called [ConexEd](#) is being implemented for online student Counseling. Counselors are being trained district-wide on this new platform.



Laney IT is working with various departments to update their infrastructure. The Athletics Weight Room and Gym areas got new TV monitors. Some work remains to connect all their equipment.





The Laney Bistro and Cafeteria are now equipped with new cash registers and an updated Point of Sale system. Chip card readers will be installed next month.



Over the Summer, IT will be working installing new computers in several areas- Financial Aid, Gateway to College and Welcome Center. Laptops for Counselors will also be updated.
