The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act



- Federal statute enforced by U.S. Department of Education.
- Requires colleges and universities participating in federal financial aid programs to:
 - maintain and disclose campus crime statistics and security information
 - provide timely warnings and emergency notifications.
- Penalties of up to \$35,000 per incident.



Specific Requirements (p. 1 of 3)

• Report Crimes and Statistics

- Disclose, collect, classify and count specified crimes
 - Type of crime and where it occurred
- On-going and annually
- Notify students and employees by Oct 1 that ASR is available
 - Deadline extended to 31 Dec for reports due in 2020

• Issue Crime Alerts

- Timely warning for any Clery Act-specified crime that is an ongoing threat to the safety of students or employees



Specific Requirements (p. 2 of 3)

- **Publish Annual Security Report**

- The 2020 Annual Security Report has been produced

- **Submit Crime Statistics**

- To U.S. Dept of Education
 - Code required to access reporting upload will not be available until November this year due to pandemic.

- **Compile a Daily Crime Log**

- Maintain and make publicly available
- The log is available at Peralta Police Services



Specific Requirements (p. 3 of 3)

- **Issue Emergency Notifications**

- Upon confirmation of significant emergency or dangerous situation involving immediate threat to health or safety

- **Have a Missing Student Procedure**

- Procedures are included in the Annual Safety Report and the Personal Safety Handbook.

- **Compile Fire Safety Information**

- Maintain fire log and compile annual fire report with statistics and policy statements



Peralta Board Policy 3515: Reporting of Crimes

“The Chancellor shall assure that, as required by law, reports are prepared of all occurrences reported to Peralta Police Services of and arrests for crimes committed on campus that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication. The Chancellor shall further assure that required reports of non-criminal acts of hate violence are prepared. Such reports shall be made available as required by law.”

Peralta Administrative Procedures 3515: Reporting of Crimes

“An annual report shall be prepared by the Vice Chancellor of General Services of all occurrences reported to Peralta Police Services and arrests for crimes committed on Peralta Community College District property. The report shall be made available to all students.”

Responsibility & Reporting



- The District contracts with the **Alameda County Sheriff's Office** (ACSO) to provide police services, also known as Peralta Police Services (PPS). An **ACSO technician is on dispatch duty** 24/7. ACSO deputies are normally on patrol from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The District also contracts with **private security guard companies** to provide security services at some locations and times not covered by ACSO.
- When ACSO deputies are not on duty, the **local Police Department** is responsible for patrol activities. The District has a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the local Police Departments in Alameda, Oakland, and Berkeley. The ACSO technician on dispatch duty at PPS can also forward calls to other law enforcement and first responder entities.
- PPS is responsible for collecting and reporting on certain crimes that are reported to them by students and employees.



What is Peralta Required to Report? (p.1/2)

- **Crimes in Categories Specified by the Clery Act**
 - Criminal homicide (murder and manslaughter)
 - Sex offenses, forcible & non-forcible
 - Aggravated assault
 - Robbery
 - Burglary
 - Motor vehicle theft
 - Arson



What is Peralta Required to Report? (p.2/2)

- Hate crimes
 - Any of the seven crimes listed above, or any other crime causing bodily injury, if motivated by race, gender, gender identity, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, national origin or disability. Amendments to the Clery Act expanded hate crimes to include: larceny-theft, simple assault, vandalism, and intimidation.
- **Arrests and discipline referrals** of students, staff, and faculty for liquor, drug and weapons law violations.



Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)

- In March 2013, President Obama signed a bill that strengthened VAWA. This bill included the Campus Sexual Violence Elimination Act (Campus SaVE), which amended the Clery Act to include reporting of the following :
 - **Dating violence**
 - **Domestic violence**
 - **Stalking**
- The Annual Security Report must also include policy statements regarding VAWA requirements addressing Sexual Harassment Policy and Procedures for Responding to Complaints of Sexual Harassment.



Emergency Communication and Notification Tools

- **911**

- Calls go directly to Oakland Police Department.

- **Campus Shield**

- Students, staff, and faculty can opt in to receive and to report situations via cell phone.

- **Fire Alarm System**

- Peralta has a District-wide system with a central monitoring station at Peralta Police Services.

- **Peralta Announcements**

- Distributed by Peralta's Public Information Office to the applicable email distribution lists. Safety and security uses include information regarding campus closures and pandemic response.

Emergency ("Blue") Phone System

- **Location and Function:** Originally installed throughout the District, these phones connect directly with Peralta Police Services.
 - Pressing the **red** button connects directly to the dispatch technician at PPS.
- **System Status:** This system is currently being refreshed. Phase I has been completed and Phase II is in progress.

Clery Act Does Not Require Reporting of All Types of Incidents

- **Examples:**

- Thefts of personal property
- Thefts of institutional property
- Assault (non-aggravated)
- Vandalism
- Unauthorized residency
- Mental health calls
- Classroom disturbances



Clery Report Structure for Each Campus



• 1. ACSO/PPS and Local Law Enforcement

Reported in accordance with Uniform Crime reporting procedures and Clery Act.

- Crimes Reported
- Quantity of Arrests/Referrals for Select Offenses (all quantities reported were arrests, no referrals reported)

• 2. Non-Police Campus Officials

Reported by campus officials who have significant responsibilities for student and campus activities, compiled in accordance with Clery Act.

- Crimes Reported (no crimes reported)
- Quantity of Arrests/Referrals for Select Offenses (no arrests or referrals reported)

Note: "RES" = Residence Dorms. Peralta does not have any residence dorms.



Berkeley City College: Overview

- **Context:** One permanent building and leased space in a near by building, each with a single main entry. No grounds or parking lots. Located in downtown Berkeley. Campus closed to the public outside of operational hours.
- **2019:** Zero crimes, arrests, or referrals for Clery Act-reportable offenses in 2019.
- **Trend:** Steadily downward from previous two years.

- **2019:** The most common crime reported was burglary. 13 of 14 arrests were for drug law violations.
- **Trend:** Crime reports and arrests/referrals increased substantially from 2017 to 2018 and decreased substantially from 2018 to 2019.
