**CITATIONS – MLA Format (2021 handbook, 9th ed.)**

Useful Formatting Tips:

- **ARRANGE** Works Cited entries in **alphabetical order** by author’s Last Name (If no author or editor given, alphabetize by Title).
- **MULTIPLE AUTHORS: 2 Authors:** Author #1 Last Name, First Name, and Author #2 First Name Last Name. *Ex: Mayr, Gerald and Helena Klomp*; **3+ Authors,** give the first author’s name, a comma, and the abbreviation et al. *Ex: Johnson, Susan B., et al.*
- **PAGE NUMBERS:** For a single page article give the number of the page preceded by a p. *Ex. p. 54.* For a multi-page article, give the range of pages preceded by a pp. *Ex: pp. 10-21.* If an article skips pages, only give the 1<sup>st</sup> page number with a plus sign. *Ex: pp. 12+.*
- **DATES:** Dates are formatted as Date Month Year. Access dates are not required but are highly recommended for online sources.
- **PARAGRAPH STYLE:** Use a **hanging indentation format** for each entry (first line at margin, rest are indented).
- **PUBLISHERS:** Abbreviate publisher names by omitting business legal abbreviations such as *Corp. Ltd. or Inc.* Abbreviate University with *U* and Press with *P* (only if a University Press). *Ex. Random House, Inc = Random House; Academic Press; Oxford University Press = Oxford UP; University of Iowa Press = U of Iowa P.*
- **SPACING:** Double-space the Works Cited list.
- **URLs vs DOIs:** For electronic sources (webpages and database items), you need to give either the source’s DOI or URL in the citation. DOIs are preferred over URLs, but not every source has a DOI. If using a URL from a database, use the permalink or “share” link, not the URL from the address bar at the top of the page. In your citation, omit *http://* from the URL.
- **IN-TEXT CITATIONS:** When quoting a source, give the author’s last name and the page number for the quote in parenthesis after the quote. *Ex. Romantic poetry is characterized by the “spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings” (Wordsworth 263).* Use only the page number in parenthesis if the author’s name is included in a signal phrase. *Ex. Wordsworth stated that Romantic poetry was marked by a “spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings” (263).* When paraphrasing, in-text citations must also be used.
