Fall 2020 Update: On July 21, UCB announced that the campus will begin the fall semester with fully remote instruction. Here are the accommodations due to the school going fully online.

1. Review UCB's FAQ page: <https://registrar.berkeley.edu/service-adjustments/instruction-faq> for important information about instructional modes (remote, in-person, hybrid, etc.) The FAQ will be updated on a daily basis. Please check this section periodically.
2. Obtain permission from Merritt College – form must be signed, no cross-outs or write outs accepted
3. Obtain approval from the UC Berkeley professor (If the Berkeley professor can't sign the form, Ms. D'Neen Perkins accept approval via email from the instructor)
4. Email the approved applications to deeprkns@berkeley.edu (Please do not send applications without ALL required signatures and approvals)
5. Ms. D'Neen Perkins will sign the approved application and send an e-copy to you via email.

Eligibility guidelines under the law for the Cross Enrollment Program under SB 1914

- Admission to a course is on a space available basis at the discretion of the host campus.
 - The student has completed at least one term at the home campus (Merritt College) as a matriculated student.
 - The student is taking at least six units at the home campus (Merritt College) during the current term.
 - The student has at least a 2.0 GPA for work already completed.
 - The student has paid the appropriate tuition required by home campus for the semester in which the student seeks to cross-enroll.
 - The student has the appropriate academic preparation, as determined by the host campus, consistent with the standard applied to currently enrolled students, i.e., met any prerequisites.
- UC Extension, summer session, and other courses not supported by the state are excluded.**

Information for UCB Instructors

SB 1914 Cross Enrollment allows students enrolled in any campus of the California Community Colleges, the California State University, or the University of California may enroll without formal admission in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either of the other systems on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities on both campuses.

Enrollment is excluded in the following areas: **Remedial, Summer Session, UC Extension & Graduate**. The work completed by a student in this program is reported to the home campus for inclusion on the student's record there. Since students in this program are not registered on the Berkeley campus, it is not possible for them to enroll via the Tele-BEARS Enrollment system. Your signature on this form approves admission to your course. The names of students enrolled through this program will not appear on your course list but will appear on the final course report for submitting grades.
