RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE PERALTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO CONVEY TWO TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS TO EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT AND CALLING PUBLIC HEARING IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, section 81310 et seq. of the California Education Code authorizes the Peralta Community College District ("District"), by two-thirds (2/3) vote of its Board of Trustees ("Board"), to convey land for public right-of-way and/or dedicate an easement to a public corporation, or private corporation engaged in the public utility business, to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, and operate water, sewer, gas, or storm drain pipes or ditches, electric or telephone lines, and access roads used in connection therewith, either with or without consideration and without a vote of the electors of the District first being taken; and

WHEREAS, District owns that certain real property adjacent to Laney College known as Peralta Junior College Civic Center Site, located at the intersection of 5th Avenue and East 8th Street, Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, in pursuit of its "East 10th Street Project," the East Bay Municipal Utility District ("EBMUD") desires two (2) temporary construction easements ("TCES") over two distinct portions of the Property for purposes of installing, constructing, and maintaining fire services tap connections and obtaining a staging area during the shutdown of an existing transmission main, including, but not limited to the storing of soil, gravel, pipes, tools, equipment, machinery, and vehicles;

WHEREAS, the portions of the Property which EBMUD plans to utilize are described and depicted in the legal description of the TCES attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, District desires to give notice of its intent to convey the TCES to EBMUD in exchange for the consideration and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Temporary Construction Easement Agreement, and further desires to call a public hearing in connection therewith.

NOW THEREFORE, the Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees hereby resolves, determines, and finds the following:

- **Section 1.** Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- <u>Section 2.</u> <u>Intent to Convey Temporary Construction Easements</u>. The District declares its intent to convey the TCES to EBMUD on, over, across, upon, and under a portions of land on the Property pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the legal description of the TCES attached hereto as Exhibit "1."
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Public Hearing.</u> The Chancellor, or designee, is hereby directed to give notice that during the regularly scheduled public meeting of the Board on **April 9, 2024 at 6 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as practicable, in the District's Board Room, located at 333 East 8th Street, Oakland, California, the Board will hold a public hearing on the question of making the conveyance of the TCES to EBMUD. Notice of the public hearing shall be given by posting copies of this Resolution, signed by at least a majority of the Board (but adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all its members), in three (3) public places within the District at least ten

(10) days prior to the hearing, and by publishing the notice once in a newspaper of general circulation in the District at least five (5) days prior to the hearing. At the time and place of the hearing, if no legal protest is entered, the Board may adopt a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all its members authorizing and directing the conveyance of the TCES to EBMUD subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Temporary Construction Easement Agreement and TCES.

EXHIBIT "A" LEGAL DESCRIPTION

All that real property situated in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, described as follows:

Being a portion of East 8th Street as shown on the map entitled "Peralta Junior College Civic Center Site", filed October 11, 1968, in Book 7 of Records of Survey at Page 27 (7 RS 27), Alameda County Records, with said street formerly known as Jefferson Street as shown on the Map of Clinton, filed June 20, 1854, in Liber "B" of Deeds at Page 537, Alameda County Records, and a portion of Block 4 as shown on the map entitled "Resubdivision of Blocks 4 & 5", filed June 10, 1889, in Liber "B" of Deeds at Page 25, Alameda County Records, more particularly described as follows:

EASEMENT #1:

A strip of land, 36 feet wide lying northeasterly of the following described line:

COMMENCING at a monument at the intersection of 5th Avenue and East 8th Street, as said streets are shown on the aforementioned map entitled "Peralta Junior College Civic Center Site" (7 RS 27), with the location of said monument designated as "15NW35" on said map and lying South 49°09'50" West 351.19 feet from a monument designated as "15NW37" as designated on said map; thence North 40°50'10" West 28.55 feet to the northwesterly line of 5th Avenue as said line is shown on the aforementioned map entitled "Peralta Junior College Civic Center Site" (7 RS 27); thence southwesterly along the last said line South 49°09'50" West 83.48 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING** of this description; thence North 40°49'56" West 290.18 feet, more or less to the southeasterly line and the extension thereof of 4th Avenue as said avenue is shown on said map, and the **POINT OF TERMINATION**.

The sideline of said strip shall be lengthened or shortened so as to begin at the northwesterly line of 5th Avenue and end at the southeasterly line of 4th Avenue as said avenues are shown on said map.




