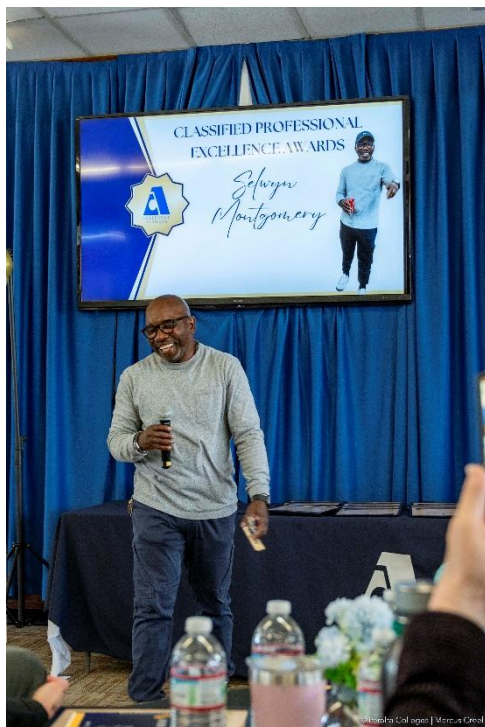


We acknowledged employees dedicated to shaping the lives of students in and out of the classroom.
