

What about Transbay Service?

- AC Transit has 18 transbay routes that cross two Bay Area bridges: Bay and Dumbarton. Transbay bus line names begin with a letter(s).
For example: F, FS, NL, O, U.
- Board any of the commute-focused lines during the week. Line schedules vary with direction and time: check before you ride.
- Take full-service transbay lines F, NL or O to San Francisco during the week or weekend. Take Line U or DB to Palo Alto.
- Once you arrive across the Bay, you will need to pay other agency fare to get around. Load cash or other agency products onto your EasyPass to pay for rides and transfers.
- Some transbay buses will be double-deckers providing lots of passenger seats along with exquisite views of the Bay.
- There are a minimum of two bike racks on transbay buses. Consider renting a bike or scooter once you arrive at your destination across the Bay.
