To this end, we will be providing information and resources from Admissions and Records, Financial Aid, Sankofa, First-Year Experience, Roots Health Clinic, Cal Fresh, EOPS, and other categorical programs. We will also offer lunch and raffle prizes to the 120 students and their families who have signed
