This is an entry level program that stacks with other programs in the Information Technology/Information Systems (IT/IS) pathway. It can be combined with the entry level program "Information Technology (IT) and Help Desk Technician" for progress toward the "Information Systems Analyst" award or the terminal "IT/Software Project Management and Automation" award. This program can be completed entirely online and is part of the California Virtual Campus-Online Educational (CVC-OEI) initiative which uses online programs in the service of workforce development.  The graduate of this program is able to oversee software endeavors undertaken to produce a product, service or result. These projects have a defined beginning and an end, a defined scope, and defined resources. A project is unique in that it is not a routine operation, but a specific set of operations designed to accomplish a singular goal. Project teams often include people who don't usually work together — sometimes from different organizations and across multiple geographies. These skills have been recognized as a distinct profession supported by an international certification body the Project Management Institute https://www.pmi.org/ and collected into a formal Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK).
