ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 4232 PASS/NO PASS

- A. Courses may be offered in either or both of the following categories:
 - 1. Courses in which all students are evaluated on a "pass-no pass" basis.
 - 2. Courses in which each student may elect on registration, or within prior to the fourth week of instruction (30% of instruction for summer session or short-term classes), to take the course on a "pass-no pass" basis.
- B. A student electing to be evaluated on the "pass-no pass" basis will receive both course credit and unit credit upon satisfactory completion of the course. In computing a student's grade-point average, grades of "pass-no pass" are omitted.
- C. A pass grade is granted for performance that is equivalent to the letter grade of "C" or better. A student who fails to perform satisfactorily will be assigned a "no pass" grade.
- D. The student is held responsible for all assignments and examinations required in the course. The standards of evaluation are identical for all students in the course.
