TENTATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PERALTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND PERALTA FEDERATION OF TEACHERS LOCAL 1603 RE: REOPENERS FOR CONTRACT YEARS 2020-2021 AND 2021-2022

The Peralta Community College District ("District") and Peralta Federation of Teachers Local 1603 ("Federation") (hereinafter collectively called "the parties") have negotiated over the salary reopeners for contract years 2020-21 and 2021-22, in accordance with page 2, item 2 of the 2019-2022 Agreement between the parties.

The parties have reached the following Tentative Agreement over salary reopeners for contract years 2020-21 and 2021-22. The 2019-2022 Agreement between the parties will be amended as follows:

Article 21. Salary

B. Salary Increases

Fiscal Year 2020-2021. There will be no salary increase for fiscal year 2020-2021.

<u>Fiscal Year 2021-2022</u>. Effective July 1, 2021, the District will provide an ongoing five percent (5%) increase in salaries for full and part-time faculty. The increase will apply to the following salary schedules:

- 1. Full Time contract faculty (25 steps)
- 2. Full Time faculty extra service schedule (1 step)
- 3. Part Time salary schedule (no other full-time employment) (25-steps) (Formerly the 75% pro-rata schedule)
- 4. Part-Time salary schedule (with other full-time non-Peralta income) (25-steps) (Formerly the 60% pro-rata schedule)

This Tentative Agreement is subject to approval by the District Board of Trustees.
